The fall 2018 enrollment for the district is 1893. Currently, TASD is comprised of two JK-4 elementary schools, a grades 5-8 middle school and grades 9-12 high school. Ground has been broken for a third district elementary school and is scheduled to open in the Fall of 2019.

Tea Area High School is located on the west side of the town at 500 W. Brian St ([map](#)). Tea Area High School's first graduating class was comprised of nine students in 2004. The class of 2018 was comprised of 81 graduating students.
