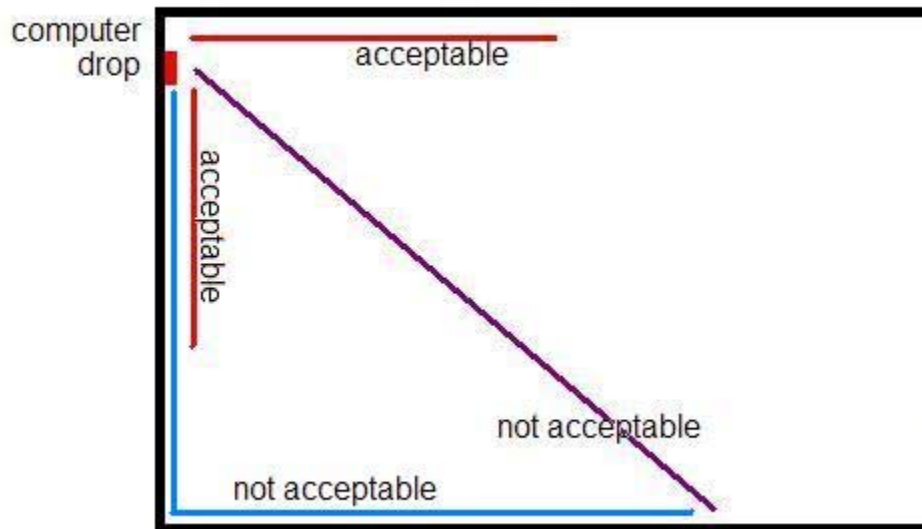


COMPUTER EQUIPMENT PLACEMENT IN CLASSROOMS



The picture above illustrates the appropriate placement of computer equipment in a classroom. Based on the location of the computer drop (where your network cord plugs in to the wall) it is advised to follow these requirements for optimal equipment usage and longevity.

Notes:

- *Computer cords should not be stretched across the room (diagonally)
- *Cords should not be stretched over doorways or windows
- *Try to avoid placing cords under heavy furniture such as file cabinets or book shelves
